1) New PAGES Working Group proposals

2) Endorsed meeting proposals

The EXCOM determined that for sessions at meetings to be endorsed by PAGES, they must be endorsed by a PAGES working group (past or current) and will then be advertised as a session of that working group.

3) ECN and SSC

Tamara Trofimova will be invited to join the SSC as the ECN representative, starting in January 2021

4) News

- The OSM/YSM has been postponed to May 2022
- A visiting Fellowship for Africa (grants to promote mobility of early-career African researchers within Africa) will be established as a pilot study. If successful it could be extended to other parts of the world
- A possible database fellowship will be explored
- Specific support for outreach in various forms will be explored
- One issue of the PAGES Magazine (April/May 2021) will be dedicated to PAGES 30th anniversary; former co-chairs will be interviewed on camera
- A possible celebration of PAGES' 30th anniversary (potentially virtual or postponed to 2021) will be explored
- Zhimin Jian will take over for Michael Evans on 1 January 2021 as PAGES co-chair
- The next SSC meeting will most probably take place online from 17 to 21 May 2021

5) Future Earth update

The Future Earth restructuring process started in 2020 following their fifth-year audit. Michael Evans was involved in the Task Force created to develop a plan in response to this external review and is now involved in the implementation team.

6) Other items
